



Dear FedEx® Customer:

FedEx Express provides import and export clearance processing for FedEx shipments, offering guaranteed delivery in 48 hours to the United States.

Effective December 14th, 2009, FedEx Express® account holders in Turks and Caicos may be subject to the following U.S. clearance-related fees, unless otherwise noted. These additional fees may be imposed by government agencies or your FedEx Customs broker, and supplementary clearance service charges may apply based on specific customer requests.

FedEx Express customers now have the option to bill clearance fees for Turks and Caicos to U.S. account holders. In order to take advantage of this option, be sure to indicate the account responsible for paying the duties and taxes on the shipping air waybill. These fees and charges will be reflected in your billing invoices as applicable to shippers or third-party customers for shipments marked as Bill Shipper or Third Party for Duty/Tax charges.
