



FedEx Ground® is implementing a new hazardous materials shipping requirement to improve safety and ensure regulatory compliance. The new requirement will not only eliminate data entry errors caused by paper manifest information being re-keyed into the system, but it will also enable FedEx to easily provide accurate information to emergency responders, in case of an incident. Information for meeting the new requirement is provided below.

FedEx Ground Hazardous Materials Shippers

Effective Aug. 1, 2011, FedEx Ground will require all hazardous materials documentation be completed and submitted electronically using a FedEx® electronic shipping solution, a FedEx recognized hazardous materials vendor software application, a FedEx® Compatible Solutions Program application or a custom solution that has the ability to transmit hazardous materials shipping information electronically.

See below for your solution for creating FedEx Ground hazardous materials OP-900LL, OP-900LG and OP-950 label and for guidance on how to comply with the new requirements.
