Value Added Services⁽¹⁾⁽²⁾

You can customise your FedEx services to your needs (or the needs of your recipients) with value added services from FedEx Express. The following are descriptions of the fees applicable to value added services.

Dangerous Goods Only available on Express Services.	 FedEx Express Dangerous Goods services allow the shipping of regulated dangerous substances and materials including door-to-door delivery and customs clearance. Applicable fee depends on the Dangerous Goods type: Accessible Dangerous Goods (ADG) The content of package must be accessible during transit for security reasons. Inaccessible Dangerous Goods (IDG) The content of package does not have to be accessed during transit and can be mixed with other freight. Dry Ice (DI) Dry ice is a hazardous commodity that requires special handling, subject to simplified regulations. This means it can be offered in locations where fully regulated Dangerous Goods services are not offered. In case a shipment contains both Dry Ice and Dangerous Goods, only the respective Dangerous Goods surcharge applies. FedEx® Electronic Trade Documents*	With FedEx Electronic Trade Documents (ETD) you can streamline your international shipments by uploading your customs documentation electronically. ETD reduces the amount of paper you print for each shipment, allows for faster pickup and helps to pre-clear your shipments, reducing the risk of your shipment being delayed in customs. No Signature Required: FedEx will attempt to obtain a signature at the delivery address. If no one is available to sign, FedEx will deliver the package in a safe place without obtaining signature. 2. Indirect Signature Required: FedEx will obtain a signature from someone at the delivery address, from a neighbour or from a building manager. If no one is available to sign, FedEx will obtain a signature from someone at the delivery address, from a neighbour or from a building manager. If no one is available to sign, FedEx will obtain a signature from someone at the delivery address only. If no one is available to sign, FedEx will attempt to redeliver the package. 4. Adult Signature Required: FedEx will obtain a signature from any person of legal age at the delivery address, subject to sighting of a valid ID. Additional Handling Surcharge	Effective January 6, 2025, FedEx will assess an Additional Handling Surcharge per eligible package for international multi-piece shipments, instead of per shipment. Package Services An Additional Handling Surcharge applies to any package that meets any of the following criteria: Dimension • measures greater than 121 centimeters along its longest side; • measures greater than 76 centimeters in length and girth (L+2W+2H). * Subject to a 40-lb. minimum billable weight. Weight • ** has an actual weight greater than 25kg. Packaging • is not fully encased in an outer shipping container; • is encased in an outer shipping container; • is encased in an outer shipping container not made of corrugated fibreboard (cardboard) materials, including but not limited to metal, wood, canvas, leather, hard plastic, soft plastic, or expanded polystyrene foam (e.g. Styrofoam); • is round or cylindrical, including (without limitation) mailing tubes, cans, buckets, barrels, tires, drums, or pails; • is bound with metal, plastic, or cloth banding, or has wheels, casters, handles, or straps (e.g., a bicycle) (including packages where the outer surface area); • could become entangled in, or cause damage to other packages or the FedEx sortation system. We reserve the right to assess additional handling charges for packages that require special handling or that require FedEx to apply additional packaging during transit. If a package is eligible for 2 or all 3 Additional Handling Surcharges, only 1 with greater charge will apply. Package shape and dimensions may change during transit, which can affect the package's surcharge eligiblity. If the dimensions change during transit, FedEx may make appropriate adjustments to the shipment charges at any time. Additional Handling Surcharge – Non-stackable ⁽⁵⁾	Effective January 6, 2025, FedEx will assess an Additional Handling Surcharge per eligible package for international multi-piece shipments, instead of per shipment. A surcharge applies to any freight handling unit that is non-stackable, which means the piece, skid, or pallet cannot be stacked vertically in a safe and secure manner. Examples include, but are not limited to, non-stackable freight handling units that: • do not have a flat and stable top or base; • may be damaged if another piece is loaded on them; or, • have flat and stable loading surfaces but are too narrow to safely and securely support other freight handling units (e.g. 1-2 barrels or drums). Measures greater than 274 centimeter along its longest side; Measures greater than 419 centimeter in length and girth - the length and girth is length plus (two times the height) plus (two times the width); Has an actual weight greater than 68 kgs. FedEx international packages will be subject to a 18 kgs. minimum billable weight when the package also meets the criteria of the Additional Handling Surcharge - Dimension. Express Freight An "Unauthorized Freight Charge" will be assessed per freight-handling unit when any of the limits below are exceeded: Measures greater than 302 centimeter along its longest side; Measures greater than 762 centimeter in length and girth - the length and girth is length plus (two times the height) plus (two times the width); Has an actual weight greater than 1995 kgs. Shipments that exceed these limits are unauthorized and may be refused, returned to the shipper, or disposed of at FedEx sole discretion. However, FedEx may accept and deliver such shipments; if accepted, this surcharge applies. Additional Line Item	 FedEx can provide clearance of shipments containing multiple commodities, however an Additional line item fee is applied to assign multiple tariff classifications. A shipment may incur this charge if: 1) it includes multiple tariff classifications above the stated «Free Lines» listed in the charges section; or 2) an identical commodity was manufactured in more than one country; or 3) multiple Commercial Invoices tendered to customs requires an individual tariff classification for each invoice; or 4) you request a separate line entry for each item in the shipment. Address Correction	If a recipient's address on an Air Bill, Air Waybill or shipping label is incomplete or incorrect, we may attempt to find the correct address and complete delivery and we will assess a surcharge. If we are unable to complete delivery, we are not liable for failing to meet our delivery commitment. For FedEx International Broker Select, the address correction surcharge will apply if the broker's address is incomplete or incorrect on the Air Waybill or other shipping documentation. If we cannot determine the correct address clarification or instructions to return the shipment. Advancement Fee	Duties, taxes and other charges might be due when importing a shipment. FedEx may advance payment of these fees as assessed by customs on behalf of the payer. Import Permits and Licenses	FedEx charges a fee for obtaining or renewing the import permit as required by local regulatory body. The charge applies to the duty and taxes payer.	OMR 15.00/shipment
Other Government Agency	The fee or fees are applied when documentation needs to be verified or an identity check has to be done by a government agency; however, fees can also be received by several agencies for the same shipment, such as local councils or commercial agencies.
